This is the physical manifestation of the magical dress I dreamed up for a print called 'SugarPlum'. The dress leaves a party after a lifetime in a wardrobe and continues to dance under the stars. I remember dreaming of dancing during the lockdown. These bones represent all our wishes as our lives were put on hold. Originally I was going to create flowers with the bones but this image came to me and wouldn't leave until I made it. In sunlight this dress casts magical shadows.

Caroline dances on dominos in polka dot tights. She is dead. She is alive. I drew Caroline and designed her crinoline skirt ten years ago but got so busy with life that the original skull and body I had sculpted in fimo clay had crumbled by the time I revisited her. Then my friend's daughter was throwing out old dolls and I found a

body perfectly fit the skirt and skull so I built around it. Her skirt is made from vintage hand crocheted lace, a friend of mine made dream catchers from doilies like this and hung them up at her wedding – I love the intricacy of the threads.



51 'The Forest' Jessica Pearce

After lockdown I finished this sculpture begun a decade ago. I collected the acorns during a trip to Texas and gilded them with copper plate. They represent the floor of a magical forest where a woman wanders only to be captured and trapped in a wooden house. I realised months after making this that she can find a way out - as the roof tiles are made from sandpaper.
